A: An raibh tú sa bhaile aréir?

B: Ní raibh. Bhí mé sa pháirc.

A: Nach raibh sé fuar.

B: Ní raibh. Bhí sé te.

### Comhrá 6

A: Dia duit.

B: Dia 's Muire duit.

A: Cén chaoi a bhfuil tú?

B: Tá mé fuar.

A: Tá sé fuar inniu.

B: Tá, ach tá sé tirim.

A: Ar mhaith leat cupán tae?

B: Ba mhaith.
