(taw un am-shir egg ay-ree foor, nakh will) The weather's getting cold, isn't it?

#### B: Tá, tá sí ag éirí an-fhuar.

(taw, taw she egg ay-ree *on*-oor) Yes, it's getting very cold.

# A: Ó, tá sé ag éirí déanach!

(oh, taw shay egg ay-ree jane-akh) Oh, it's getting late.

#### Caithfidh mé imeacht.

(ka-hee may im-akht) I have to go.

#### #2 A: Cá raibh tú inné?

(kaw rev too in-yay) Where were you yesterday?

### Bhí imní ag teacht orainn.

(vee im-ree egg chakht oreen) We were getting worried.

#### B: Bhí mé tinn. Bhí slaghdán orm.

(vee may cheen) (vee sly-dawn or-um)

I was sick. I had a cold.

## A: Ó, dona go leor.

(oh, dunna go lyore) Oh, too bad.

## Tá slaghdán ag teacht ormsa freisin.

(taw sly-dawn egg chakht or-um-suh fresh-in) I'm getting a cold, too.

# B: Bhuel, tá biseach ag teacht orm anois, buíochas le Dia.

(well, taw bish-akh egg chakht or-um un-ish, bwee-khus le jee-uh) Well, I'm getting better now, thank God.
