

Review Conversation:

- #1 A: **Dia duit.**
(jee-yuh ghwitch)
Hello.
- B: **Dia 's Muire duit.**
(jee-yuh smuirra ghwitch)
Hello.
- A: **Is mise Máire.** **Cén t-ainm atá ortsá?**
(iss misha moyra) (kane tan-im uh-taw ort-sah)
I am Mary. What's *your* name?
- B: **Is mise Seán.** **Conas atá tú, a Mháire?**
(iss misha shawn) (kunnus uh-taw too, uh woyra)
I am John. How are you, Mary?
- A: **Tá mé go maith.** **Agus tú féin, a Sheáin?**
(taw may go mah) (oguss too fane, uh hyoyn)
I'm well. And *yourself*, John?
- B: **Tá mé go h-iontach, go raibh maith agat.**
(taw may go heen-takh, gurra mah hoggut)
I'm wonderful, thank you.
- A: **Tá sé te inniu, nach bhfuil?**
(taw shay cheh in-yoo, nakh will)
It's hot today, isn't it?
- B: **Tá, ach níl sé grianmhar.**
(taw, akh neel shay green-wur)
Yes, but it's not sunny.
- A: **Bhí sé an-scamallach inné freisin.**
(vee shay on skom-al-akh in-yay fresh-in)
It was very cloudy yesterday, too.
- B: **Bhí, cinnte.**
(vee, keen-chuh)
It sure was. (Yes, certainly.)
- An mbíonn an aimsir mar seo i gcónaí?**
(un mee-un un am-shir mar shoh ih goe-nee)
Is the weather always like this?
- A: **Ní bhíonn, de ghnáth.**
(nee vee-un, de ghnaw)
No, not usually.

- A: **An bhfuil tú i do chónaí sa cheantar seo?**
(un will too ih doh kho-nee suh khyan-tur shoh)
Do you live in these parts?
- B: **Níl. Tá mé i mo chónaí i mBoston.**
(neel; taw may ih moh kho-nee ih moss-ton)
No. I live in Boston.
- A: **Cén fáth go bhfuil tú i San Diego?**
(kane faw go will too ih San Diego)
Why are you in San Diego?
- B: **Tá mé ag dul chuig bainis. Tá mo chara ag pósadh.**
(taw may egg dull hig ban-ish; taw moh khar-ah egg poe-sah)
I'm going to a wedding. My friend is getting married.
- A: **Agus cá bhfuil an bhainis?**
(ogguss kaw will un wan-ish)
And where is the wedding?
- B: **Beidh sí thuas i nDel Mar. Tá mé ag dul suas ansinanois.**
(bay shee hoo-usss ih nell mar; taw may egg dull soo-usss un-shin un-ish)
It will be up in Del Mar. I'm going up there now.
- A: **An bhfuil síob uait?**
(un will sheeb wet)
Do you need a ride?
- B: **Níl, go raibh maith agat. Tá carr agam.**
(neel, gurra mah hoggut; taw kawr oggum)
No, thanks. I have a car.
- A: **An mbeidh tú ag damhsa anocht, mar sin?**
(un may too egg dow-sah un-okht, mar shin)
So, will you be dancing tonight?
- B: **Ní bheidh, maise. Tá tinneas cinn orm.**
(nee vay, moosh-uh; taw chin-uuss keen or-um)
No way. I have a headache.
- A: **Tá brón orm. Ó, tá sé ag éirí déanach!**
(taw broan or-um; oe, taw shay egg ay-ree jane-akh)
I'm sorry. Oh, it's getting late!
- B: **Tá, agus tá deifir orm. Caithfidh mé imeacht anois. Slán!**
(taw, ogguss taw jeffer or-um; kah-hee may im-akht un-ish; slawn)
Yes, and I'm in a hurry. I have to go now. Bye!
- A: **Slán leat!**
(slawn lyat)
Bye!
